Each camper will make a difference in creating an atmosphere of faith, friendship, and fun. Every camper has an important responsibility to contribute to the overall success of Camp. We will follow the Church guidelines for dress and behavior, as detailed in the **For the Strength of Youth** pamphlet. If you do not have a copy of this pamphlet, contact your Bishop or Young Women President. Following these standards and rules will help ensure we achieve our camp goals.

## Goal 1: To Build Relationships with Heavenly Father and Jesus Christ

Invite the Spirit into Camp by living all of the standards in the For the Strength of Youth pamphlet.

Pray and read the scriptures daily.

Keep the Word of Wisdom (no smoking, drugs, or alcohol).

Dress consistently with Church standards of modesty.

Modest shirts, pants, and shorts - no tank tops, bare midriffs, tight, sheer, revealing or sleeveless tops, no short shorts

Modest swimsuit - one piece, and tankinis acceptable, no bare midriff, or low cut in front.

No body piercings except for ears.

## Goal 2: To Build Relationships with Families, Other Young Women, and Leaders in the Gospel

- Build friendships with other girls and leaders by treating everyone with respect and kindness.
- Do not cause anyone harm, hurt feelings, or extra work. Pranks, vandalism or graffiti are forbidden.
- Use language carefully (no swearing, gossiping, put-downs, or lying).
- Respect the person and belongings of everyone else. Also, remember you are responsible for everything you bring. Leave unnecessary valuables at home (money, jewelry, electronics etc).
- Be on time for meals, all assigned duties, and scheduled activities.
- Cooperate with adult leaders and follow their instructions and guidance.
- Stay within the boundaries of camp. Late arrivals or early departures must be approved in advance.
- Cell phones are permitted for taking pictures. Permission must be given before taking a picture of another person. No taking pictures in bathroom (Loss or damage of cell phone is at the risk of the participant).

### Goal 3: To Build Relationships with Nature

- Enjoy and protect the natural setting of Camp. Keep camp areas clean and organized. Place trash in trash cans and pick up any litter.
- For safety and friendship, be with at least one buddy at all times.
- To conserve water, showers must be short (3 minutes).
- Appreciate the beauty of yourself and others. Minimize makeup, and styling hair; plan to participate in swimming and recreational activities throughout the day.

### Camper's Pledge of Cooperation:

I agree to abide by all camp rules and instructions, both in letter and in spirit. I agree not to leave camp. I agree to stay with the leader of my group and under her supervision at all times, without exception.
